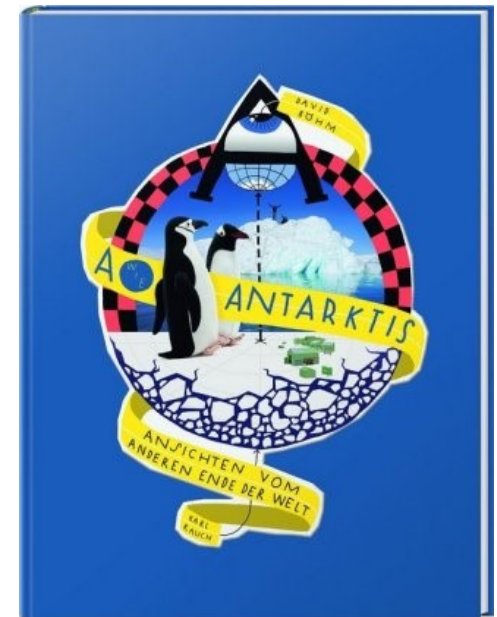

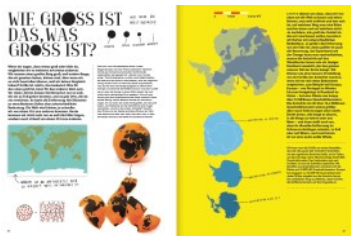
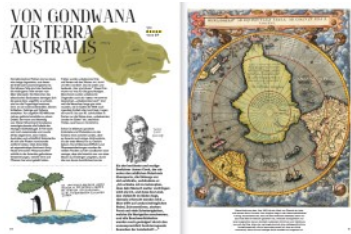

In preparation for the book, he travelled to Antarctica with his 10- and 11-year-old sons, gaining his own experiences gathering impressions of the continent. He found out that in the Antarctic you can make do with far less than we can imagine.
