The Wolf and the Fly

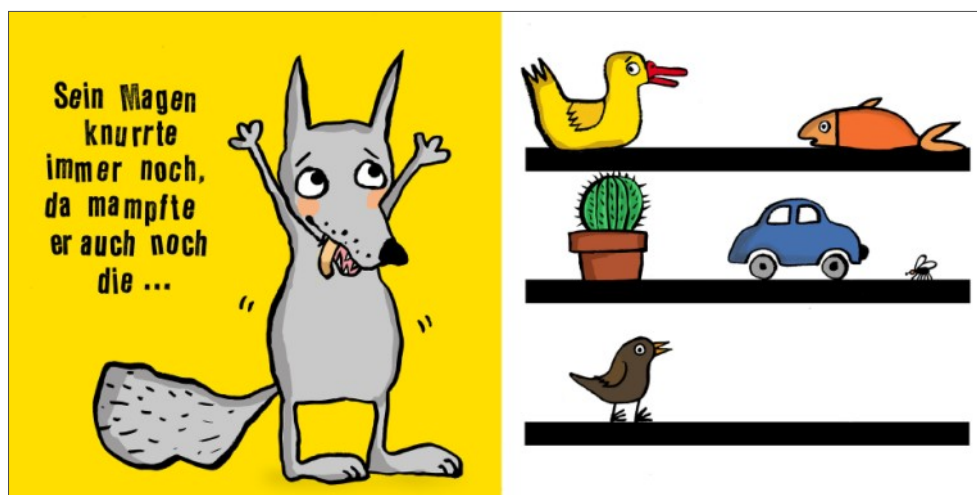
The wolf is sooo hungry. And what could be more natural than eating all his toys?
