What does he keep hollering about? And why?

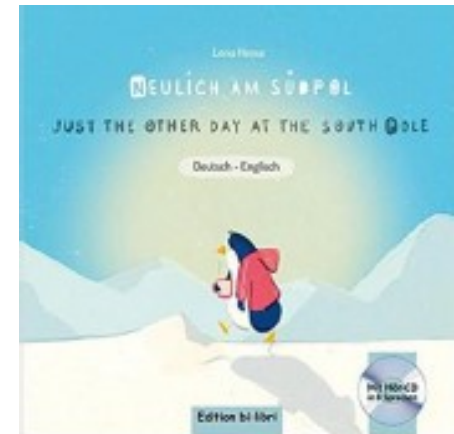
A charming story about living in a multilingual society and the understanding of languages.
